

From September 2017 Moorlands Nursery School will be offering a limited number of 30 hour Extended Free Early Years Education places to eligible families with 3 & 4 year old children. Priority for these places will be given to our existing families first.

Session times for the 30 hours free education will be 8:30am until 2:30pm. Parents will be asked to provide a packed lunch for their child. If parents wish to extend the session until 3:30pm which is when the afternoon session finishes for children accessing 15 hours of universal entitlement, they can do so at a cost of £3.50 per session.

It is the responsibility of parents to check if they are eligible for the Free Extended Early Years Education place and they are then required to bring their National Insurance Number and the 11 digit code they are given from the online checker, into Nursery School to secure a 30 hour place.
